Academic Overview

IBDP is a rigorous academic program aimed at challenging students to be original thinkers and confident and conscientious learners. This program prepares students, aged 16 to 19, for success at university life and beyond. The IBDP has gained recognition from top universities around the world. At EIS, the following subjects are offered at the Diploma level. Students are asked to choose one subject from each of the 6 groups and study 3 at Higher Level (HL) and 3 at Standard Level (SL).

Grading

MYP

For students in class 9 and 10, grading is from 1 to 7, with 7 being the highest. MYP eAssessments are currently optional for MYP students. Students are also required to complete five Service as Action activities along with a Personal Project to gain their MYP certificate.

IBDP

Students in the Diploma Program are assessed based on IB grades from 1 to 7, with 7 being the highest. They also complete the Extended Essay, Theory of Knowledge (ToK) and Creativity, Action and Service (CAS) component to successfully gain their IB Diploma. EIS does not rank its students.
